SUBJECT: Clarification of STEP Grant Issues – Fly America Act

Many of the 2011 SBA STEP Grantees are planning international trips. The default rule requires all individuals traveling on funds provided by the federal government must fly U.S. Flag Carriers, e.g., American, United, Delta, US Airways, etc. Even when a foreign airline may cost less or is more convenient, the individual must still fly the U.S. flag carrier. Limited exceptions exist, and any traveler seeking the exception must obtain written approval from the SBA prior to the trip. See the attached for further information and guidance.
